4 Sara put a blanket on the ground to sit on. She started to read her favorite book. The warm sun was on her face.

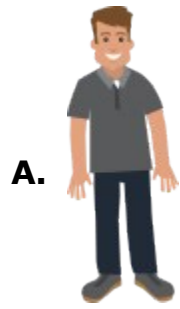
5 Steve suddenly started to yell, "I caught one! I caught one!"

6 Steve put the fish he caught in a bucket. The fish splashed water all over Sara's book.

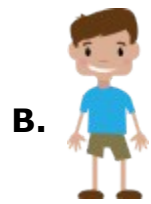
7 "Bad fish!" Sara said trying to dry her book.

8 Soon it was time to leave the lake. Steve happily put his bucket of fish in the truck. Sara was upset over her sunburn and wet book.

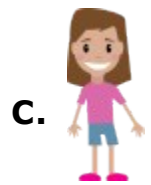

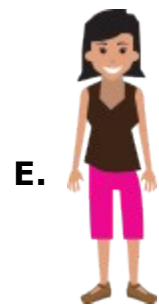

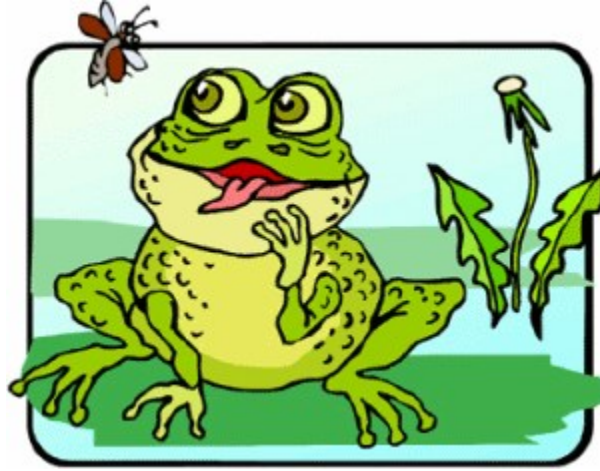
