Dear Parent/Guardian -

CPS has partnered with pediatric mobile medical providers to bring NO COST, quality health care services to the children in our communities. Your consent for treatment will also allow the mobile provider assigned to your school/area to immunize the child for whom you signed consent. All providers use immunization guidelines from the Centers for Disease Control (CDC) and Illinois Department of Public Health (IDPH). **Your child will receive the vaccines that are due based on the childhood vaccine schedule and the vaccine records available for review.** If you have vaccine records, please send them with your child on the day of their visit.

You have the option to say that you do not want a specific vaccine (note on consent form), but please know many vaccines are required for your child to be in school [https://www.cps.edu/OSHW/Documents/MinimumHealthRequirements\\_English.pdf](https://www.cps.edu/OSHW/Documents/MinimumHealthRequirements_English.pdf). Mobile providers also give recommended vaccines (Hepatitis A, HPV, Men-B, flu, etc.) because they are important for keeping your child healthy. Records of the services received will be given to your child following their visit. Please share these records with your child's Primary Care Provider.

You may come with your child, but we know this is often not possible. Please provide a working phone number where they can reach you, if needed.
